LIBRARIAN PERFORMANCE:

I am the subject specialist and liaison for the Departments of English, WLAC, and Africana Studies. Besides maintaining the budgets and collection building for these areas, I provide class instruction (in collaboration with faculty to various degrees) and research support on an individual or group basis. I am also responsible for sharing information with my departments, and maintaining any online artifacts connected to these departments such as research guides, adding to the internal Q&A page, updating ScholarWorks with any deposits that may have been sent to from faculty, and with answering any questions around navigating new databases. Additionally, I may engage in various community specific outreach projects in my liaison areas. Previously this included, assisting with developing an organizational system for lending with the collection housed in the Luis Alberto Ambroggio Center for the Spanish Department, hosting a book discussion for a visiting author Kevin Brockmeier with the English Department. Currently this includes assisting the Africana Studies Department with the assessing/restructuring of their program model. In addition to being the Humanities Librarian, I assumed 20%-time responsibilities for creating a Copyright Service Model. In addition to taking point on fielding any incoming client specific questions, I was tasked with designing a service framework for a tiered model of copyright support, and online training that enforces a baseline of copyright knowledge for my peers. Any obligations for the copyright responsibilities completed this summer.
